Floodplain

Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA)

- Land inundated by water
 - 100 year flood
 - 1% chance occurring/year
- State & Local jurisdiction for compliance
- Typically includes wetlands & watersheds
- Provides protection
 - Lakes
 - Streams/tributaries
 - Rivers


Protection of floodplain Areas...

 "...Encourage the preservation of the <u>natural and beneficial functions</u> <u>of the floodplain</u>."

Oklahoma Statutes Title 82-1602 (B)(1)

 "...The purpose of the Oklahoma Floodplain Management Act... Protect the <u>natural and beneficial functions of the floodplain</u>, to reduce damage and disruption to property from floods, to reduce costs of disaster relief and to reduce injury and loss of life from floods..."
